Forbes, Parkes and Eugowra creatives are invited to showcase their work as part of the *Unknown Art Exhibition*, hosted by Forbes Arts Society.

Based on the national Incognito Art Show, *Unknown* is an inclusive, community art exhibition...with a twist.

So, what's the twist?

All artworks are exhibited anonymously. Only once an artwork is purchased will the artist's name be revealed to the buyer on the back of the artwork.

All artworks are the same size and sold for \$100, regardless of artist - beginner, emerging or professional.

Unknown aims to increase the profile of regional arts, financially support local creatives, provide beginner and emerging artists with an opportunity to exhibit their work, increase regional access and exposure to the arts, as well as inspire a new generation of art collectors and supporters through affordable art.

An exhibition opening event will be held on the Friday 31 March 2023. The exhibition will then be on public display until Monday 3 April 2023. Location TBC.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- No entry fee for works.
- Limit of 2 entries per person.
- All canvas artworks are to be 30.5cm x 30.5cm in size. Canvases are not to be framed.
- Canvases will be supplied at no cost to Forbes, Parkes and Eugowra residents. Limited availability. Please contact hello@forbesartssociety.com to arrange collection of your canvas/es.
- Other art forms (watercolour, weaving) will also be accepted, including three dimensional entries (sculpture, ceramics etc) that fit within 30.5cm x 30.5cm x 30.5cm.
- All entries must be the original work of the entrant. The entrant is deemed to have accepted sole responsibility for ensuring that the work submitted does not infringe on any relevant copyright law.
- All works must be available for purchase for \$100 (total value), including commission.
- Works will be available for purchase both in person and online via the Forbes Arts Society online shop.
- A 25% commission will be charged on all sales for FAS members and 30% for nonmembers or non-financial members.
- Labels will be fixed on the reverse side showing artists name and title.
- Picture Hanging Cord will be affixed to all canvases by a member/s of the Forbes Arts Society.
- A member/s of the Forbes Arts Society committee will supervise the onsite gallery throughout the event.
- The Forbes Arts Society will exercise extreme care with works submitted but will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any item whilst it is in their custody.
- The Forbes Arts Society reserves the right to have entries reproduced in any media and promotional capacity.
- All work will be displayed at the discretion of the Forbes Arts Society.
- The Forbes Arts Society reserves the right to exclude work from the display if it does not comply with the Conditions of Entry, or if the work is deemed inappropriate or offensive.
- Exhibition to run from 31/03/2023 until 3/4/2023. Location TBC.
